

Caller ID

Allows you see the name and number of the person calling you before you answer the phone.

How to use:

1. When you receive a call, wait until your phone completes the first ring signal.
2. The name and phone number of the person calling you will automatically appear on your display screen.
3. If you choose to answer the call, the number will remain on the screen until you or the caller hangs up.

Note: Caller ID requires a display unit phone. If you do not have a phone with the display on it, a display unit box is available for sale through Golden West.

If the letter “P” or “private” appears on the screen, the caller may have blocked the display of their number by pressing *67 (or dialing 1167 on a rotary phone), before placing the call. You can choose to answer the call or not.

If “unknown number” appears on the screen, the caller is in an area that does not record Caller ID services.
